

SOCIAL FORESTRY - RESTORATION OF DEGRADED FORESTS

Community-driven forest conservation, restoration and afforestation of 500+ hectares of land in the neighbouring watersheds in the Khasi Hills as well as across other parts of Meghalaya through assisted natural regeneration (ANR) to revive the ecosystem of the Mawphlang Sacred Forest in the Khasi Hills, which has faced over 10% deforestation rate.



IMPACT & BENEFITS



Restoration of degraded forests will be achieved by supporting communities in land management and forest regeneration activities that will yield livelihood benefits



Greater involvement of women in seed selection, nursery management and planting activities.



Estimated Emission Reduction: 35,000 tonnes/year
